

AN INTRODUCTION TO GOGEBIC COUNTY

Gogebic County was established in 1887 and consists of 1,112 square miles. Iron ore was discovered in 1884 and soon immigrants were attracted to the county to work in the mines and woods. The Chicago & Northwestern Railway provided these people with easy access.

The Gogebic Range prospered during the 1890s with the demand for steel rails for railroads which were crossing the nation. As a result small mining camps grew into wayward cities within a single season. This type of development attracted many immigrants. The Range became home to a variety of eastern European immigrants.
