AN INTRODUCTION TO ONTONAGON COUNTY

Many early French and English travelers during the colonial era visited the future Ontonagon County to see the famed Ontonagon Boulder. The French and English beginning in the 1730s attempted to develop the copper deposits in the area. The English probably brought along Cornish miners. After Douglass Houghton reported on the copper in the county the area was opened to settlement. The county was created in 1843 and organized in 1846. There was a demand for laborers and the first immigrants – Cornish, French Canadians, Germans and Irish – came to settle and work in the mines and related industries.
