International Travel and Study Abroad Scholarship

- Origin:** Global Outlook Fund established by the College of Business in 2006.
- Eligibility:** Students must be enrolled full time at Northern Michigan University in the College of Business. Scholarship funds must be applied to the cost of participating in a semester- or year-long NMU affiliated program (students studying abroad during the summer semester may be considered if they are enrolled full time) or on faculty-led travel programs.
- Students must be at least of sophomore status.
- Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Application:** Application forms are available from the Office of International Programs at 145 Whitman Hall. Completed forms have to be submitted to that office. Attach the most recent copy of your resumé with your application.
- Preferences:** Preference is given to students who:
1. Choose to study business courses while on their study or travel abroad
 2. Choose to participate in a business focused internship while abroad
 3. Choose to study in a developing country
 4. Choose to study abroad for an academic year
- Award:** \$500
- Number:** Number of awards varies
- Nominated By:** The Office of International Programs will interview the applicants and select the recipients
