Languages, Literature, and International Studies



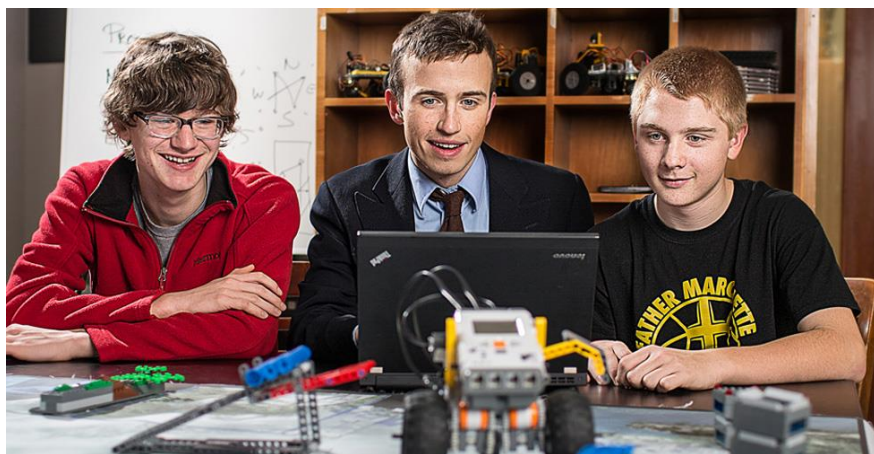
