

Application Process

- Apply [online](#) or download a [printed application](#) (recommended to be completed 2-3 semesters before intended transfer).
- Pay the \$35 application fee.
- Arrange to have official transcripts mailed to NMU (when first applying and then when finished at your current or previous college). Official transcripts need to be mailed or submitted in a sealed envelope from your previous institution (official e-transcripts are accepted via most electronic services).
- Schedule a campus visit (optional, but highly recommended) at nmu.edu/visit or by calling 906-227-2650.
- Contact your [transfer admissions counselor](#) if you have questions about the steps or need guidance.

Housing

- Set aside \$50 for the housing application (and an additional \$200 deposit due by June 1 to maintain the application).
- Learn about the [housing policy requirement](#) and who is eligible for which locations.
 - On-campus housing options: Residence halls, on-campus apartments, upper-classman residence hall (Spooner)

Once Admitted

- You will receive a transfer credit evaluation (TCE) within 2-3 weeks by mail.
- [Activate your MyNMU](#) account.
- [Register for orientation](#) (required for all students new to NMU) and pay orientation fees.
- Learn about course placement requirements at www.nmu.edu/orientation/courseplacement
- [Setup your on-campus living arrangements](#) or explore your [off-campus housing options](#), if applicable
- Purchase a parking permit at \$140/year for one car on campus.
- Consider a [recreational facilities pass](#).
- Start saving up for books. Amount depends on course load and class requirements. You can charge textbooks to your NMU account through the [NMU Bookstore](#). You can also reserve your textbooks and have them all ready for pickup when you arrive.
- Course registration occurs during the orientation session (for in-person sessions), or at a specified date for online orientation.
