Applications for continuing students will be accepted as follows:

Fall semester: July 15 through the second Wednesday after the start of the semester (10th calendar day).

**Winter semester:** November 1 through the second Wednesday after the start of the semester. **Summer semester:** March 15 through the second Wednesday after the start of the semester.

NOTE: Applications for summer semester will only be accepted for students enrolled in on-campus courses over the summer. Students enrolled in only web courses or no summer courses should apply for fall. Tuition rate for web courses is the same for both in-state and out-of-state residents.
