



**Guaranteed Admission Agreement
Nicolet College and Northern Michigan University**

1. PURPOSE

This agreement is designed to facilitate the transfer and guaranteed admission of Nicolet College University Transfer Liberal Arts students to Northern Michigan University.

2. PROVISIONS

Qualified Nicolet College students will be guaranteed admission to Northern Michigan University as a transfer student after fulfilling the specified requirements:

- a. Enroll as a new freshman at Nicolet College in the University Transfer Liberal Arts program.
- b. Submit the Declaration of Intent to Participate to Nicolet College advisor prior to completing 30 credits through Nicolet's University Transfer Liberal Arts program.
- c. Complete the University Transfer Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree.
- d. Earn a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA and a 2.0 GPA in the term prior to transfer.
- e. Meet minimum transfer requirements for admission to Northern Michigan University.
- f. Apply online for transfer admission to Northern Michigan University at www.nmu.edu/admissions/applyto
 - i. Northern Michigan University application deadlines will be in effect.
 - ii. Include a note in the personal statement indicating participation in the Guaranteed Admission Agreement along with a copy of the signed Declaration of Intent to Participate.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Admission to Northern Michigan University does not guarantee admission to a specific academic major or program.
- This agreement does not guarantee bachelor degree completion within four years.

3. TERMS

- a. The Agreement shall become effective on the 1st day of June, 2019 and shall automatically renew unless terminated with a one year notice from either party as provided by this agreement.
- b. This agreement is subject to review if either Nicolet Area Technical College or Northern Michigan University undergoes curriculum revisions.

1. Enroll as a new freshman at Nicolet College in the University Transfer Liberal Arts program.

3. Complete the University Transfer Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree within three years of the initial enrollment. Maintain enrollment at Nicolet College during this three year period.
4. Earn a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA and a 2.0 GPA in the term prior to transfer.
5. Meet minimum transfer requirements for admission to Northern Michigan University.

 - i. Northern Michigan University application deadlines will be in effect.
 - ii. Include a note in the personal statement indicating participation in the Guaranteed Admission Agreement along with a copy of the signed Declaration of Intent to Participate
