## ADDITIONAL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- At least 16 credits of the 20 required credits in Criminal Justice Electives must be at the 300+ level;
- An overall GPA of 2.00 and a "C" grade or better is required for all Criminal Justice courses within the major;
- At least 8 credits of the major and 4 credits of the minor must be earned at NMU;
- NMU's General Education Program and all graduation requirements must be completed by the student, including the World Cultures requirement, Laboratory Science requirement, and Math and English Competency requirement.
