ADDITIONAL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- At least 8 credits of the 16 credits of the Loss Prevention Management Electives must be at the 300+ level;
- An overall GPA of 2.00 and a "C" grade or better is required for all Loss Prevention Management courses within the major;
- At least 8 credits of the major and 4 credits of the minor must be earned at NMU;
- The General Education Program and all graduation requirements must be successfully completed; including World Cultures, Laboratory Science, English Competency and Mathematics Competency.
