MEMO OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) BETWEEN

NORTHERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY AND

NORTHCENTRAL TECHNICAL COLLEGE

Northern Michigan University (NMU) and Northcentral Technical College (NTC) have and will continue to establish direct transfer pathways for students wishing to transfer to NMU for any bachelor of science or arts degree. NMU and NTC agree to cooperate in communication with each other and their common and respective publics concerning the established relationship between the two institutions. Faculty and staff at both institutions will share the information in this agreement with interested and qualified students, and both institutions will counsel and advise students and prospective students.

The MOU between NTC and NMU includes the following:

- 1. Students who graduate with an associate in applied science degree or an associate in science degree and who transfer up to 90 semester hours of credit from NTC will have those credits accepted by NMU and applied toward the 120 semester hours minimum required for the bachelor's degree. If a course has no NMU equivalent and no NMU home department can be established, the course will be assigned general elective credit.
- 2. Transfer courses must meet the following:
 - a. Completed with a grade of C- or better
 - b. No transfer credit is granted for remedial courses
 - c. Transfer credit is not granted for departmental advance placement unless a grade is awarded and the course is included in semester earned hours.
- 3. To obtain the Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Arts degree from NMU, students will need to accomplish the following:
 - a. Complete a minimum of 120 semester hours
 - b. Meet NMU general education requirements
 - c. Meet NMU graduation requirements
 - d. Achieve a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0
 - e. Successfully complete program requirements
 - f. Complete a minimum of 30 semester hours of credit in residence at Northern Michigan University, excluding advanced placement credit. Transfer students must earn a minimum of eight credits in each major and four credits in each minor.

NMU is committed to providing quality education to NTC students, and NTC will inform students about this articulation as a part of this agreement.

This agreement is effective upon its signing and will stay in effect unless rescinded or changed with a 30-day notice by either party.
