

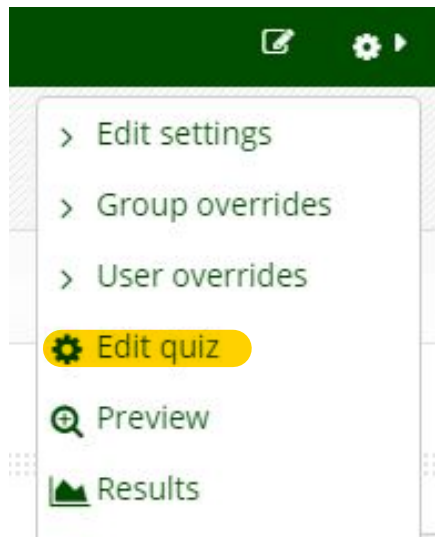
## Adding Questions to a Quiz

This tutorial assumes that you already have questions in the question bank for your course. If you do not yet have questions in your question bank, view the **Creating Questions** tutorial.

### Adding Quiz Questions —How to

Begin by logging in to EduCat and turning editing on in your course:

1. Scroll down to the section containing the Quiz to which you would like to add the questions, and click to open the quiz screen.
2. On the top right of your EduCat page, you will find a Gear icon. Click on it and a drop-down menu will appear. Select **Edit quiz**.



3. If you would like to add specific questions to the quiz, click the **Add** drop-down menu, and select **from question bank**.

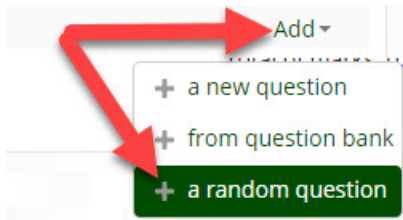

6. If you would like to select additional questions from other categories, repeat steps 3 through 5.

7. If you would like to add one or more questions selected randomly from a specific category, click the **Add** drop-down menu, and select a **random question**.



8. On the **add a random question** screen:

1. Select a category from which you would like to choose questions to add to your quiz.
2. From the drop-down menu, select the number of random questions you would like to add from the selected category\*.
3. Click the **Add random question** button.

\*Note: the drop-down lists numbers 1 through 10, and then 20,30,40, etc. If you would like to add 17 random questions from this category, you would select **10**, click the **add** button, then select **7**, and click the **add** button again.
