



Students can upload a video to an instructor's podcast if the instructor has set it up to allow uploads.

The first step in uploading to an instructor's podcast is to log in at <https://wildcast.nmu.edu>




A login form titled "Login to your account". It features two input fields: "Username" and "Password". Below the password field is a checkbox labeled "Stay signed in" and a green "Login" button.

Once logged in, you will see a list of podcasts that you have access to. To upload to a podcast, click on the **Upload** Button in the desired podcast's information box.
