Learning Circles 101 *Facilitation Questions*

Learning Circle Structure

- If possible, send email reminders to the group a few days before each meeting.
- Be welcoming. In general, sitting in a circle, in a comfortable setting is helpful. Have coffee and tea available. Begin with some time for socializing.

Possible General Discussion Prompts

- What did you learn?
- What was most surprising?
- How does this compare with your previous understanding?
- How might this change your teaching?
- Is there anything that you disagreed with or had questions about?
- Are there any cultural implications?
- Do you have further questions?

Scholarship of Teaching Prompts

- Are you interested in learning more about this topic?
- Would this idea work across disciplines?
- Is this an idea that could be developed into scholarship?
