Olson Library - Changes

- Searching for tenure-track librarian to replace Krista Clumpner
- Restructuring administrative staff so that Prof. Clumpner's replacement does not need to be a supervisor
- 30 % reduction in library acquisitions budget over 2 years
- No longer providing 24/7 study space (only happened in Fall 2020)
- Returning to hosting programs and exhibits
- Resume full services, including study rooms & virtual reality
- Increasing relationships with students, especially through student organizations

Olson Library – Future possibilities

- Copyright & open licensing support
- Open Education Resources (OER)
- Research data management
- Digital scholarship
- Scholarly communication & digital publishing

Archives - Priorities

- UP Digitization Network (UPLINK)
- Collection processing & digitization

Archives – Staffing changes

- Using 1-time reserve funds to increase Prof. Robyns from 10 months to 12 months
- Using grant funds to hire 2-year Digitization Specialist for UPLINK project
- Working with HR to consider options to restructure ½ time TOP position

Archives – Future possibilities

- Expanded online and in-person exhibits
- Increased instruction and curriculum development related to use of primary sources
- Increased digitization of manuscript collections
