PE 346 Adaptive Physical Education: We were granted the designation of ASL because of our content goals of service learning for students. The course objectives were heavily designed around quality field experiences for NMU students who work with local schools, teachers, and students in a hands-on educational setting. This unique partnership enables students to learn in real-life applications how to engage, motivate, and adapt the learning environment for students with special needs.

PE 350 Methods and Materials: This course is also designated an ASL course because NMU students learn to apply the teaching and delivery methodologies learned in the classroom within local physical education classrooms. This student-teacher preparatory course helps the teacher candidate develop their personal teaching style through curricular development, and allows for in-class application through a partnership with local schools.

Through the efforts of students in this class, we were also able to receive a grant to purchase additional physical education equipment to use while working with local private and public schools.
