Spooner Hall Single occupancy rooms in Spooner Hall are connected to an adjacent single occupancy room by a shared bathroom. The furnishings in single rooms include an extra-long twin bed, dresser, study desk and chair, wastebasket, and window blinds. The three-room efficiency apartments in Spooner Hall include a private bathroom, a bedroom, and a living area which contain an apartment-size refrigerator and stove. Furnishings include two extra-long twin beds, a dresser, two study desks and chairs, wastebaskets, and window blinds. Spooner also has a laundry room (the laundry fee is included in the rate), cable TV service in every room (included in the room rate), and two social lounges for use by residents and their guests.

<u>Woodland Park</u> The complex consists of a combination of studio, one- and two-bedroom apartments, as well as four-bedroom units. There is a commons area centrally located in the complex that has a lounge and community room, a kitchen, study space, a small fitness center and laundry facilities. All apartments are carpeted and furnished with a stove, refrigerator, microwave, kitchen table and chairs, extra-long twin bed(s), dresser(s), night stand(s), desk(s), living room chair, couch, coffee table, end table(s), and window blinds. Rent includes all utilities plus cable television, local phone service, and wireless computer network access. Laundry facilities are located on each floor. Barrier free units are available.

<u>Check-in/Check-out</u> In order to accomplish room and apartment cleaning and other maintenance after the close of the winter semester, in most cases, the earliest a Summer College student can check into their single room or efficiency apartment is **Saturday**, **May 9**. Similarly, in order to prepare the rooms and apartments for occupancy in the fall, the latest a student may check out is **Sunday**, **August 9**.

<u>University Computer Network Services</u> The rooms and apartments are equipped with a wireless network system, so you will be able to connect your laptop or desktop to the University's network and the internet anywhere in your apartment without making a physical connection. The Help Desk number is 906-227-2468 and can aid you in any NMU networking questions.

<u>Past Behavior/Criminal Activity</u> Past Behavior/Criminal Activity: Northern Michigan University reserves the right to determine at its discretion that past behavior and/or criminal activity on the part of an applicant for University housing is such that the interests of the University, students, and/or the applicant would be best served if the applicant was not permitted to live on campus.

There are three questions in this regard on the application. A student who answers 'yes' to any of these questions will be subject to a background check and must send a written statement of relevant facts with appropriate documentation from either the school or the court that adjudicated the charges to the Assistant Director of Housing Operations, 3502 C.B. Hedgcock, Northern Michigan University, Marquette, MI 49855-5301 no later than 10 days after submitting the housing application and prior to moving into University housing. If any 'no' answer changes to 'yes' after the application is submitted, but prior to the applicant's moving into University housing, the student must submit the statement of relevant facts within three days of the event(s) which resulted in the change and prior to moving into University housing. The applicant's statement and documentation will be handled confidentially.

A student who answers 'yes' to any of these questions will not be assigned to University housing until a determination of the applicant's eligibility is made following the recommendation from the background check, or a review of the provided statement and documentation by the Director of Housing and Residence Life or a committee consisting of one representative each from the Housing and Residence Life Office, the Admissions Office, the Dean of Students Office, and the Police Department. The student will be notified of the decision in writing. Any false statement in this regard may lead to a rejection of the single student apartment application or immediate termination of the student's housing contract.

Roommate Assignment The Housing and Residence Life Office will make every effort to accommodate a specific roommate preference if you are requesting a multiple person room or apartment without a specific roommate preference. Note that students requesting a specific roommate must both request the other person on their application.

<u>Alcoholic Beverages</u> In accordance with applicable University policies, the possession and consumption of alcohol is permitted in Woodland Park and Spooner Hall rooms, apartments, and the TV lounge under certain circumstances for those students who are 21 years of age or older.

<u>Pets</u> Pets, except fish, are prohibited in University residence halls and apartments. Fish tanks, one per living unit, cannot exceed 10 gallons. For an exception to this regulation for service or assistance animals, please contact Disability Services.

Smoking. Northern Michigan University is a tobacco-free campus. The use of any tobacco product, including but not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, pipes, chewing tobacco, and e-cigarettes is prohibited in or on <u>any</u> property owned by NMU (with the exception of the NMU golf course and personal vehicles with the windows closed). This includes on-campus apartments. Please see <u>www.nmu.edu/tobaccofree</u> for more information.

<u>Weapons</u> Weapons are not permitted anywhere on campus except when properly stored in the NMU Police Department's weapons storage room.

<u>Cancellation of Reservation</u> Unless alternative arrangements are made, reservations will be held until 1:00 PM of the first day of classes for the summer session for which the student has requested housing. A summer applicant may cancel their room or apartment reservation by notifying the Housing and Residence Life Office in writing. <u>A \$50 housing cancellation fee will be charged unless written notice of cancellation is received in the Housing and Residence Life Office at least five working days before the first day of the housing reservation.</u>
