Homecoming is a traditional week of activities every fall at Northern Michigan University put on to engage the study body and encourage school spirit. The Special Events Committee is working energetically to make Homecoming 2010 as great as last year. The goals of the Special Events Committee continue to be participation from NMU and Marquette communities, as well as promotion both on and off campus. The following is a breakdown of each event:

Dead River Games – This is a time-honored Homecoming event. It will be held Sunday, September 19 from 2-4 p.m. at the Dead River Basin near Presque Isle. Activities will include an obstacle course, an ice cream scoop competition, a sand sculpture competition and an egg toss. This is typically the most popular and well-attended event of Homecoming week.

Scavenger Hunt – The Scavenger Hunt requires participants to go out and search for various items on a list provided to them. A winner is determined based on the most items found in the shortest amount of time. The event will be held on Monday, September 20 in the Great Lakes Rooms at 6:30 p.m.

Stepping Competition – Returning for its third year, teams participating in the Stepping Competition incorporate synchronized dancing with rhythmic stomping to create an exciting and memorable performance. The event will be held on Tuesday, September 21 at 7 p.m. in Jamrich Hall 102.

King & Queen Competition – The King & Queen Competition will be held on Wednesday, September 22 in the Great Lakes Rooms at 7 p.m. Participants are judged on theme wear and formal wear. Students in the audience will have the opportunity to participate in an audience vote, which will be added into the judges scoring to determine the top five finalists in each category. These finalists will compete in a final question and answer round to determine the winner. Each year, the King & Queen Competition is hosted by a comedian who also performs during the tallying of the students votes between rounds two and three.

Parade – The NMU Homecoming parade will be held on Friday, September 24 beginning at 5:30 p.m. Hundreds of spectators from all over the NMU and Marquette communities line the streets to show their support for the Wildcats. Participating is open to student organizations, sports teams and alumni and includes three judged categories: Decorated Car, Spirit Banner and Marching Units, and Floats.

Spirit Police – In order to increase promotion before Homecoming and target more students, including commuter and non-traditional, the Special Events Committee is continuing the “Spirit Police” program. Members of the committee will be patrolling campus and events the week prior to Homecoming and “ticketing” individuals who are showing their school spirit. These students can redeem their ticket in the Academic Mall to get promotional items for Homecoming.
