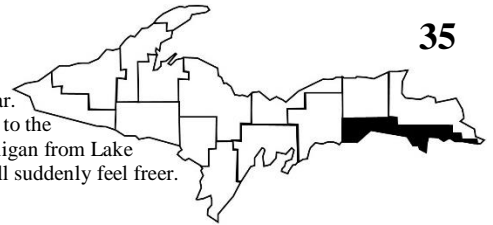


Mackinac County, MI
