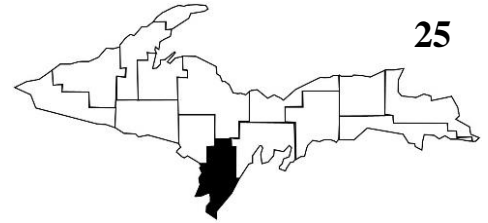


# Menominee County, MI
